Problem

On CREPORT/BAS line 35 refers to a nonexistent line 900. In the MERGE program line 520 ends in a comma. Line 2200 of PTMAINT is incorrect.

Solution

The problem is corrected by following the steps listed below.

1. Backup the diskette(s) and make the changes on the Backup copy of the program.
2. In BASIC load the program by typing LOAD"PTMAINT".
3. Make the following corrections:

4. Type SAVE"PTMAINT" to save the changes in the program.
5. Load the next program by typing LOAD"CREPORT/BAS".
6. Make the following corrections:

DELETIONS (Type the line number and press <ENTER>)

7. Type SAVE"CREPORT/BAS" to save the changes in the program.
8. Load the next program by typing LOAD"MERGE".
9. Make the following corrections:

CHANGES (Edit the line number by referring to the owners manual)

Delete the comma at the end of line 520, or retype the line.

10. Type SAVE"MERGE" to save the changes in the program.
11. At TRSDOS Ready, make a backup copy of the corrected diskette.
